


## Revealing Snippets From “The Language of God in the Universe.”



When this happens, they are gradually reborn to reflect Yahshua's righteous image. Accepting the need for His redeeming sacrifice on the Cross allows people to escape the darkness they are in and to enter the light of Yahweh's glorious presence once more. Through Yahshua and His Spirit, people again earn the right to call Yahweh their Father, and begin to understand how God has always communicated His perfect nature to them.
